Herd Recording: Getting Started


Step 1: Complete the Cow Enrolment Worksheet

Use the Cow Enrollment Worksheet to record information on all the cows currently in your herd. Every cow in your herd should be recorded on this worksheet. If you do not have complete data on every cow, fill in all the information you have. If you purchased cows, it is a good idea to record the previous owner so we can match the cow with her previous performance information.

Step 3: Complete the Calving Worksheet

If you already have calving information and/or weaning weights on a calf crop, use the Calving Worksheet to record the information. Only record tattoo of sire and dam on this form since detailed information on all cows and bulls in your herd were recorded in Steps 1 and 2.

Step 4: Send the Worksheets to BIO

When we receive your Worksheets, we will generate reports and summaries of your herd performance. This will be returned to you along with detailed guides in a Herd Recording Binder.

Herd Recording Report Summary

Herd Management Report

This report provides a snapshot of your herd's performance including a breeding summary, calving summary and distribution, as well as a growth performance summary.

Herd Performance Report (5-Year Performance)

The 5-Year Performance Summary is a useful report to use to evaluate performance trends in your herd. Are you weaning more pounds per cow now than five years ago? Birth, weaning, and yearling trends are all summarized for your entire herd. As well, this report provides provincial averages use a performance benchmarks.

Cow Productivity Report

The Cow Productivity Report provides a detailed performance list of all the cows that are in your herd. The average performance of all progeny are summarized for birth, weaning, and yearling growth performance. As well, genetic evaluations (ABCs) are reported that can be used to identify superior cows as well as potential culls due to low performance.

Cow-Calf Birth Report

The Cow-Calf Birth report is a detailed list of all the calves born in your herd with their calving ease and birth weight information. As well, there is a calving season summary that includes the percentage of assisted births, length of calving season, and average birth weight. These statistics are also summarized for each sire used your herd.

Weaning Report

The Weaning Report provides a detailed performance listing of each calf raised in your herd. Birth information as well as weaning growth performance is reported. Adjusted weaning weights and weaning indexes are reported to compare calf performance within your herd. As well, genetic evaluations (ABCs) are reported that can be used as a basis for selection of calves to go into BIO's Bull and Heifer Evaluation Programs and also for selection of replacement females. Feedlot buyers are starting to demand genetic information, which this report provides.

Yearling Report

The Yearling Report provides a detailed performance listing of each animal in your herd that was weighed as a yearling. On this report, birth, weaning, and yearling performance data are reported. Adjusted yearling weights and yearling indexes are reported to compare calves from growth from weaning to yearling. As well, genetic evaluations (ABCs) are reported that can be used for selection of replacement animals.

Sire Productivity Report

The Sire Productivity Report provides a detailed performance list of all the sires used in your herd in the past 3 years. Progeny performance averages are provided at birth, weaning, and yearling. As well, genetic evaluations (ABCs) are reported that can be used to evaluate the genetic ability of the sires in your herd. Having ABCs on all your sires is useful so you can compare them to ABCs from bulls that you may want to bring into your herd.

Calving Worksheets - Instructions

The Calving Worksheet is used to record the calving and birth weight information for all calves born in your herd. The worksheet comes pre-printed with information for each cow in your herd. You just need to fill in the calf information, including sire identification, calving ease, and birth weight (optional but recommended). The information collected on this report is used to produce the Birth Report, which provides summaries of your calving season.

Optionally, you can keep this worksheet until the calves are weaned, and record weaning information on the same worksheet. However, it is recommended to complete and submit the Calving Worksheet before you take weaning weights. It is much easier to record your weaning weights on the Weaning Worksheet, rather than the Calving Worksheet. Also, by submitting the Calving Worksheet before weaning, you will get the Birth Report for your herd.

Calving Season Information

This information is used to calculate overall herd performance. Keeping track of the females calving in your herd helps be aware of calving success and maintain an inventory of cattle in your herd.

Number of females exposed to breeding (last year): Record the number of cows and heifers exposed to breeding in the previous season. Include cows that were sold or removed from the herd after the breeding season. Also include cows that were purchased between breeding and calving.

Number of females that calved this year: Record the number of cows and heifers that calved this year. Include cows that had a dead calf

Number of females disposed because:

- a) **Open:** Record cows and heifers that were disposed after the breeding season because they were not in calf
- b) **Died:** Record number of cows and bred heifers that died between the breeding season and calving
- c) **Sold for breeding:** Record number of cows and bred heifers that were sold for breeding
- d) **Culled:** Record number of cows and heifers that were removed from the herd for any other reason

Number of calves born dead: self-explanatory

Number of calves born alive: Number of females that calved minus number of calves born dead

Number of calves born alive but died: self explanatory

Weaning Weigh Date: If the Calving Worksheet is used for recording weaning weights, record the date the calves were weighed.

Castration Date: If calves were castrated before weaning, record the date. If calves were castrated at birth, record 'at birth'.

Creep date: If calves were given access to creep feed, record the date when feed was introduced.

Cow information

The cow information is pre-printed on the Calving Worksheet. All cows that were not recorded as disposed in the previous calving season are included as well as all cows added on the Dam Enrolment Worksheet.

At the end of the pre-printed cow information are several blank rows to record calving information on cows that were added to your herd since you last submitted a dam enrolment form. More detailed information for cows added to your herd should be recorded on the Dam enrolment form.

Disp Code (Disposal Code): If a cow was removed from the herd, you must record a disposal code. This ensures that she does not show up on next year's calving worksheet.

Disposal Code	Reason
D	Died
S	Sold for breeding
3	Culled because of calving problems
4	Culled because calf dies at birth or shortly after
5	Culled because cow/ heifer was open
6	Culled because of disposition
7	Culled because of teat/udder problems
8	Culled because of old age
9	Culled because of unsound feed/legs
10	Culled because of inferior calf performance

Sire Information

Use this section to record the identity of the sire for each calf born in your herd. Only the tattoo and/or name of the sire is required. More detailed information on each sire should be included on the Bull Battery form.

Sire Tattoo: Record the tattoo of the sire. BIO evaluated bulls have tattoo recorded on their performance certificate.

Sire ID: Record the way you identify the calf's sire. This is usually the bull's name, but could be the ear tag number.

Calf Information

Calf tattoo: Record the calf tattoo in this area. Even if you do not physically tattoo your herd, you need to create a unique tattoo number for each animal. The correct tattoo format is: Herd letter – animal number – year code letter. For example, the first calf born in 2002 in ABC Farm's herd would be tattooed: ABC1M. Be sure to record the correct year code letter for the birth year.

Calf Ear tag: Record the tag number of the calf. This is usually the animal number portion of the tattoo.

Birth date: Record the exact birth date of the calf as: DAY / MONTH / YEAR. If birth dates are out by even a few days, incorrect adjustments and calculations are would be calculated.

Sex: Record the birth sex of the calf, as H=Heifer or B=Bull

Calv Ease (Calving Ease): Recording the type of assistance required at calving as follows:

Code	Calving Ease
U	Unassisted (unobserved or not assisted)
E	Easy Pull (minimal assistance with no mechanical help required)
H	Hard Pull (difficult, required a mechanical calf puller or chains)
S	Surgical (Caesarean Section)
M	Malpresentation (calf turned / leg back/ twisted, etc.)

Birth type: Indicate the birth type as follows:

S	Single
T	Twin
TR	Triplet
ET	Embryo transfer (record the donor cow information in comments)

Raised As: Record the way the calf was raised as follows:

S	Single
T	Twin
TR	Triplet
O	Orphan
FH	Foster calf born within the herd (this is a single calf raised by another cow)
FP	Foster calf purchased outside the herd (indicate birth date, sex, and breed of calf)
FT	Foster calf born within the herd and put on a cow that is already raising her own calf
PT	Foster calf purchased outside the herd and put on to a cow that is already raising her own calf

Birth Weight: Record the birth weight in pounds taken as close to birth as possible (within 24 hours). Only weights that were actually taken should be reported (do not use tapes to estimate birth weight).

Disp Code (Disposal Code): If the calf is no longer in your herd, please indicate this by reporting a disposal code:

D	Died
S	Sold

Weaning Information

It is suggested that you send you calving worksheet to BIO as soon as you have finished calving. BIO will process the data, and send you a weaning worksheet to record the weaning information. However, you can wait until you wean your calves before submitting this worksheet.

Calves should be weighed when the average age of the group is 200 days. However adjusted weaning weight and ABCs will be calculated for calves weighed from 120 to 280 days of age, if they meet the management group requirement.

Mgmt Group (Management Group): Record the management group number that the calf is in. In order to accurately identify genetically superior animals, calves must be compared to others that have received the same management. Calves raised together in the same herd should be placed in the same management group, provided they were born within 90 days of each other. Herds split into 2 pastures for the summer should receive different management group numbers. Heifers, bulls and steers can be in the same weaning management group. All cattle in a management group must be weighed on the same day with the same scales.

Wean Sex (Sex at weaning): Record the sex of the calf at weaning (H=Heifer B=Bull S=Steer)

Weight (weight at weaning): This is also known as the 200-day weight. Record the actual weight in pounds.

Weight Date: Record the date the calf was weighed in the DAY/MONTH/YEAR format.

Comments: Record any comment regarding the weaning weight of the calf

Calf National ID: Record the National Identification number of the calf. Be sure to record all 9 digits (i.e. 123 456 789)
